Course Suitability

Students are assessed to determine the most suitable and appropriate training. We do this by conducting a pre-training review which may include information about other courses completed, your current skills and written tasks.

Course Duration 1 day a week for 1 year.

Fees and Charges

Please visit our website or contact our office for current fees and charges. Full price fee for students is \$250 (concession fee is \$50). This training is delivered with Victorian and Commonwealth Government funding, which pays for the rest of the course. Enrolment into this course may impact your entitlement to future government funded training.

Training and Assessment Training consists of course notes and activities in the classroom with selfpaced learning and on excursions. Assessments involve a variety of methods including demonstrations, short answer questions and observation. Qualifications and Recognition Students will be issued with a Certificate I in Transition Education upon successful completion of the course, or a Statement of Attainment for successful completion of individual units.
