Course Suitability:

Students are assessed to determine the most suitable and appropriate training. We do this by conducting a pre-training review, which may include information about other courses completed, your current skills and written tasks.

This training is delivered with Victorian and Commonwealth Government funding, which pays for the majority of the course. Enrolment into this course may impact your entitlement to future government funded training.

Training and Assessment:

Training consists of course notes and activities in the classroom with self-paced learning and on excursions. Assessments involve a variety of methods including demonstrations, short answer questions and observation.

Qualifications and Recognition:

Students will be issued with a Certificate I in Initial Adult Literacy and Numeracy upon successful completion of the course, or a Statement of Attainment for successful completion of individual units.

Career Pathways:

Students will be supported to improve their employability and work readiness, and be better prepared to engage in work options and access pathways to further specific vocational education and training.
