This course assists learners to develop life skills and supports self-development so they can explore suitable future options such as employment, further study, or community participation. It helps to develop knowledge of community support services, strategies for personal safety and daily activities such as travel and medical emergency procedures and to develop personal goals and simple strategies to achieve them.

It will also build skills in using technology, planning, and implementing travel plans, problem solving, teamwork and gaining independence.

Entry Requirements

To enrol in a Life Skills Victoria Inc course, a person must be at least 18 years old and must have evidence of a permanent cognitive impairment or intellectual disability. Students will be required to complete a numeracy and literacy assessment.

Course Duration

This course will be delivered one day per week over a 12 month period.

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Course Suitability:

Students are assessed to determine the most suitable and appropriate training. We do this by conducting a pre-training review which may include information about other courses completed, your current skills and written tasks.

This training is delivered with Victorian and Commonwealth Government funding, which pays for the majority of the course. Enrolment into this course may impact your entitlement to future government funded training.

Training and Assessment:

Training consists of course notes and activities in the classroom with self-paced learning and on excursions. Assessments involve a variety of methods including demonstrations, short answer questions and observation.

Qualifications and Recognition:

Students will be issued with a Certificate I in Transition Education upon successful completion of the course, or a Statement of Attainment for successful completion of individual units.
